



BSc Hons Management Practice - Aviation Sector (Part time)

Programme overview

The BSc Hons Management Practice is designed to assist those practising or aspiring managers wishing to update their skills and competencies and achieve a primary degree. It is intended that participants will use their learning to enhance not just their own personal and professional development but to stimulate business improvement in their own organisation. Programme design and delivery is intensive and challenging yet recognises busy management schedules and keeps in mind work-life balance.

Small group sizes and a high degree of class participation all enhance your learning experience and provide excellent networking opportunities. Throughout the programme, you are encouraged to apply new skills to your own organisation straight away resulting in increased personal effectiveness and generating impact in your organisation, your community and the economy. The programme is offered on a part-time basis to facilitate busy managers and ensure that there is appropriate transfer of theory into practice.

Year 1 consists of six taught modules and equates to 120 credit points at Level 4. However, normally Year 1 is not taught but participants address the learning outcomes of the programme by completing a portfolio of evidence.

Year 2 consists of six taught modules and equates to 120 credit points at Level 5. The modules delivered will be unique to the needs of the Aviation sector.*

*Successful participants who do not wish to complete year 3 will be eligible for the Advanced Diploma in Management Practice award.

Year 3 consists of five taught modules and equates to 120 credit points at Level 6.

Normally delivery is through two full day workshops for each taught module and participants undertake work-based learning and independent study. Assessment is by work-based assignments that capture the immediate application of theory to your own practice.

If you are a professional who wants an academic management qualification or a manager looking to develop your existing skills, this programme is tailored for you.
